Uniquely Los Alamos

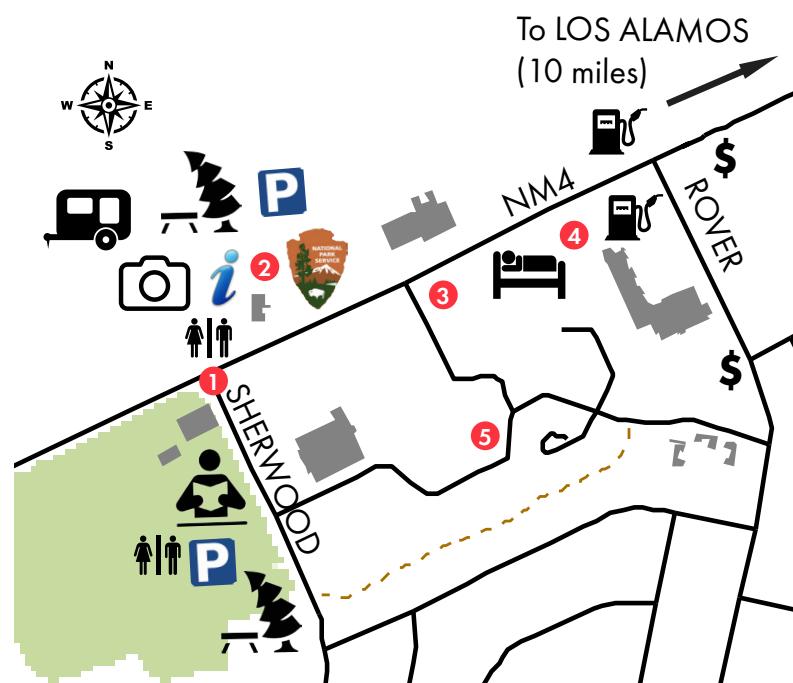

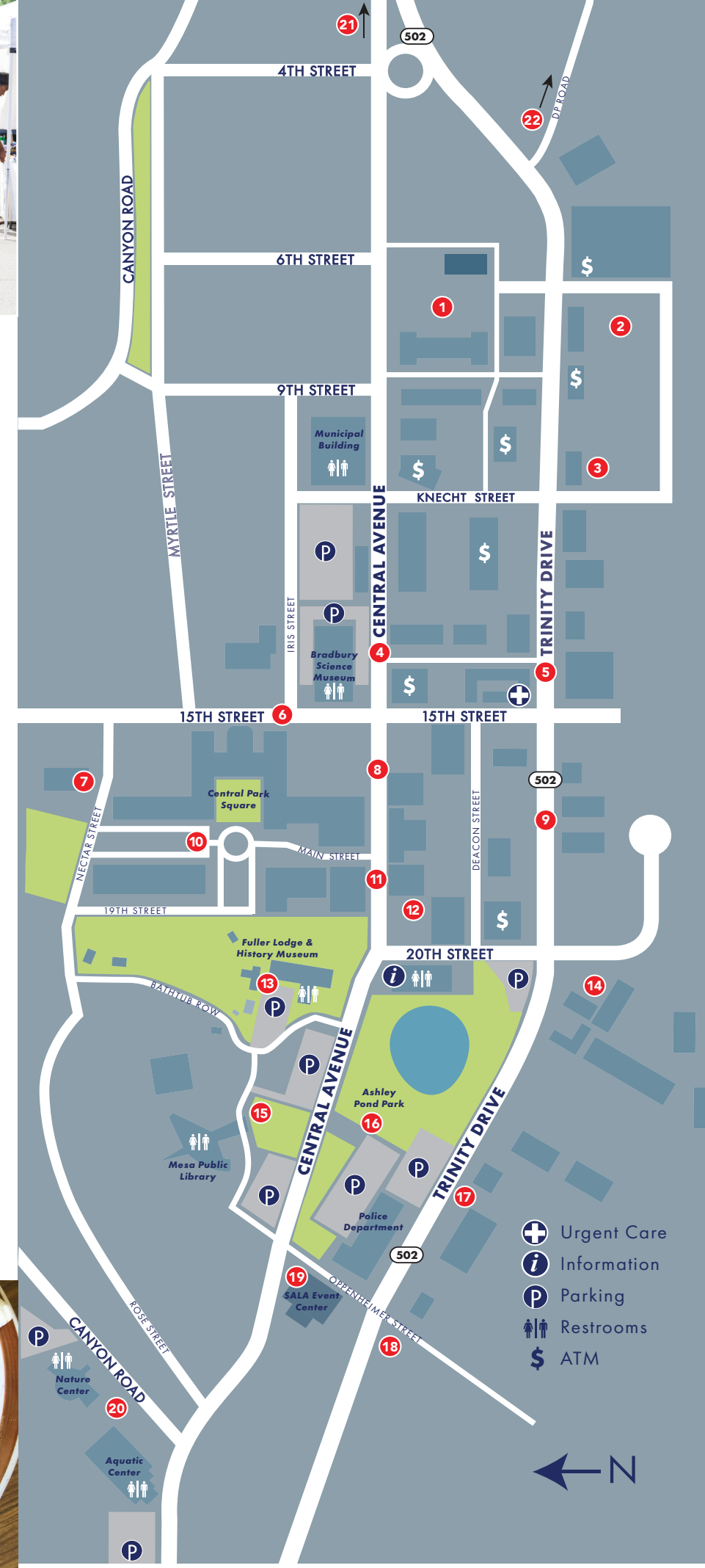
